The primary objective of this class is to fulfill NCIC and CJIS security policy training requirements of training agency personnel for full access to all NCIC, NLETS, and WCJIN files/interfaces.

This course is designed for full time dispatch personnel who are responsible for conducting all transaction types for the agency via the WCJIN System.

The course will cover:

- A thorough overview of NCIC, NLETS and WCJIN, and CJIS policies and procedures
- A thorough review of information sources available to criminal justice agencies
- Terminal usage procedures and inquiry requirements
- Requirements and procedures for entering and maintaining records in the various NCIC files

Attendees are required to take a test at the conclusion of this course to display their competence in system usage and policy/procedure requirements. Individuals passing the test then receive a full access license valid for two years.
